CONDITION OF ENTRY:

Championship Stake is a Stake confined to Gundogs (as approved by the ANKC) that have been placed first in a Restricted Stake or first, second or third in an All Age Stake or have the title All Age Retrieving Dog (AARD).

Evidence of eligibility to compete in a Championship Stake must be supplied for all dogs entered that are not RT Ch, RRD, AARD. Please email these to palabaz@bigpond.com or please send a hard copy via post.

Under Tasmanian State Law, the Gun Licence must be carried at all times whilst handling the gun.

Trial venues are private property and must not be revisited at any time after the Trial.

Bitches in oestrum will not be permitted to compete or enter the trial site. They may be on the property but not in the vicinity of the Trial Site or area of the runs.

ALL DOGS on the trial site must be on a lead at all times (except when competing or being exercised), the lead must be held in the hand or the dog tethered.

PROTESTS:

A protest committee will be appointed to deal with any official, written protests received during the Trial. Any protest must be received in writing on the day of the Trial and include the reason for the protest and be accompanied by **§100**. If a protest is upheld the money will be refunded.
