Classes: (Strictly closed ages)

Baby Puppy 3 months - 1 day under 6 months Minor Puppy 6 months - 1 day under 9 months Puppy 9 months - 1 day under 12 months Junior 12 months - 1 day under 18 months Intermediate 18 months - 1 day under 24 months Open 24 months (2 years and over)

Order of Judging:

Saturday: LSC Baby to Intermediate and SC Baby to Intermediate.

Sunday: Commence with individuals for all Open Classes for LSC and SC.

Followed with Sires Progeny, Dams Progeny, Breeders Group. The officiating judge will be supported by the WA Breed Survey panel for these specialist classes

Then run offs for the Open Classes

Morning and afternoon tea breaks and lunch breaks will be taken at appropriate times. Junior Showmanship Classes will be conducted in the lunch break.

Sires and dams progeny groups: Must be a minimum of 5 progeny with animals from Baby Puppy upwards. Entry of progeny is automatic and progeny will be take part in the class. The Sire/Dam need not be present. Sires/Dams must be successfully breed surveyed. The progeny must come from a minimum of two different sires or dams for the relevant group.

Breeders Group: Animals in the Group must carry the breeder's prefix. The Group must consist of five (5) animals from more than one sire or dam and be 9 months or older and entered in the show. Entries to be provided to the Show Chair by the completion of judging on the Saturday

Junior Showmanship Classes: Junior - 7 to under 10 years; Intermediate - 10 years to under 13 years; Senior – 13 years to under 18 years. These classes can be entered on the day.

o Sire and Dams Progeny, Breeders Group and Junior Handlers are all free.

Please Note: A 5 generation pedigree must be included with the entry of all animals in entered in the Open Classes (both dogs & bitches). Please note in accordance with GSDCA guidelines open animals will be subject to a gun test and complete an off lead gaiting exercise.

Awards:

Trophies and a rosette for class winners. Place rosettes to 5th place in each Class. Animals that are ungraded do not receive trophies or rosettes.

The title **State Sieger and State Siegerin** will be awarded to the winner of the Open Dog and Bitch who have been awarded the grading of **Excellent Merit** at that show respectively.

Gradings: will be awarded at the Judge's discretion: 'Promising' and 'Very Promising' in Baby, Minor and Puppy classes. 'Good' and 'Very Good' in Junior, Intermediate and Open class. The gradings of 'Excellent' and 'Excellent Merit' will only be awarded to exhibits 24 months and over and exhibited in the Open classes.

<u>GSDCA Excellent Merit grading</u>: May only be awarded to animals exhibited in the Open Class and classified GSDCA Breed Survey Class 1 or equivalent as recognised by the GSDCA; animals that the judge considers to be of high anatomical worth, type, quality and have a potential for or have demonstrated attributes that will produce animals that are of above, or far above average, in terms of type and quality.

<u>GSDCA Excellent grading</u>: May only be awarded in the Open Class and to animals that are successfully classified through the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme, or recognised as such by the GSDCA.

Grading Certificates: To all eligible graded animals. Gradings are only awarded at the judge's discretion.
