Mr Kerry Lee (Vic)

Kerry has been in the dog world all his life. He has been a renowned breeder of Kerry Blue Terriers and Fox Terriers, Wire and Smooth. In addition he spent about 30 years in the Weimaraner breed. An All Breeds judge of international standing, he is currently the Victorian Judges Education Group Leader for the Terrier Group trainees.

Ms Kerry King (SA)

Kerry has been involved in the Terrier Group for 30 years, where under the BRASSHEAD prefix she has bred, shown and owned Bull Terriers & Staffordshire Bull Terriers. She currently has bred 7 ROM bull terriers, multiple Grand Champions & Australian Champions and owned and co-owned many more. She has also shown many Bull Terrier Miniatures to their ROM status.

Mr Bill Mooney (Vic)

Bill has been in the dog fancy since 1973, showing and breeding Dobermanns with some success and showing and breeding whippets for the last twenty three years under the ELMARO prefix. He has been involved with both all breed and breed clubs on a number of committees. In addition, Bill has also been on the judges training scheme for several years, both as a trainer and a tester.

Mrs Maureen Hanley (NSW)

Maureen's involvement with pure breed dogs began in 1974 with the purchase of their first Golden Retriever, a breed which they have loved, owned, shown and bred ever since.

In 1987 they added an American Cocker to their kennel with the pleasure of showing, breeding and loving these beautiful small spaniels. Maureen gained her first Judge's license in 1988 and became All Breeds in 2011

Mr Roger Bridgford (Vic)

Roger has been involved with pure breed dogs most of his life. Both his parents were All Breeds Judges, exhibiting several Gundog Breeds, including English Setters, Pointers, Labrador Retrievers and Cocker Spaniels. As a five year old he was given a Welsh Corgi (Pembroke) by his parents as a Christmas present in 1943 and continued to show Welsh Corgis until around 1968. As a young lad he exported the first Welsh Corgi into New Zealand. Roger purchased my first Golden Retriever in 1957 and with his wife still breeds and exhibits Golden Retrievers regularly, under the TAUMAC prefix, with great success.

Mrs Kay Sneath

Kay has been involved in the sport of dogs since 1972 when her parents bought her an Afghan Hound. However, with her family, she is best known for her Marakhoff Borzois. Kay has had the privilege of judging in most states of Australia, NZ, Japan, USA, Canada and South Africa. She has a long history in Hounds but a love of Terriers was formed early when handling Grenpark Smooth Fox Terriers for the legendary Cam Milward.

Mrs Caroline Yate (NSW)

The AEUKANMANUVA (pronounced "you can manoeuvre") prefix was established in Christchurch, New Zealand when Caroline brought her first Siberian Husky, Kumak in 1991.
