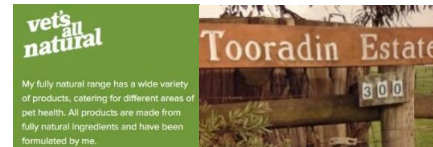

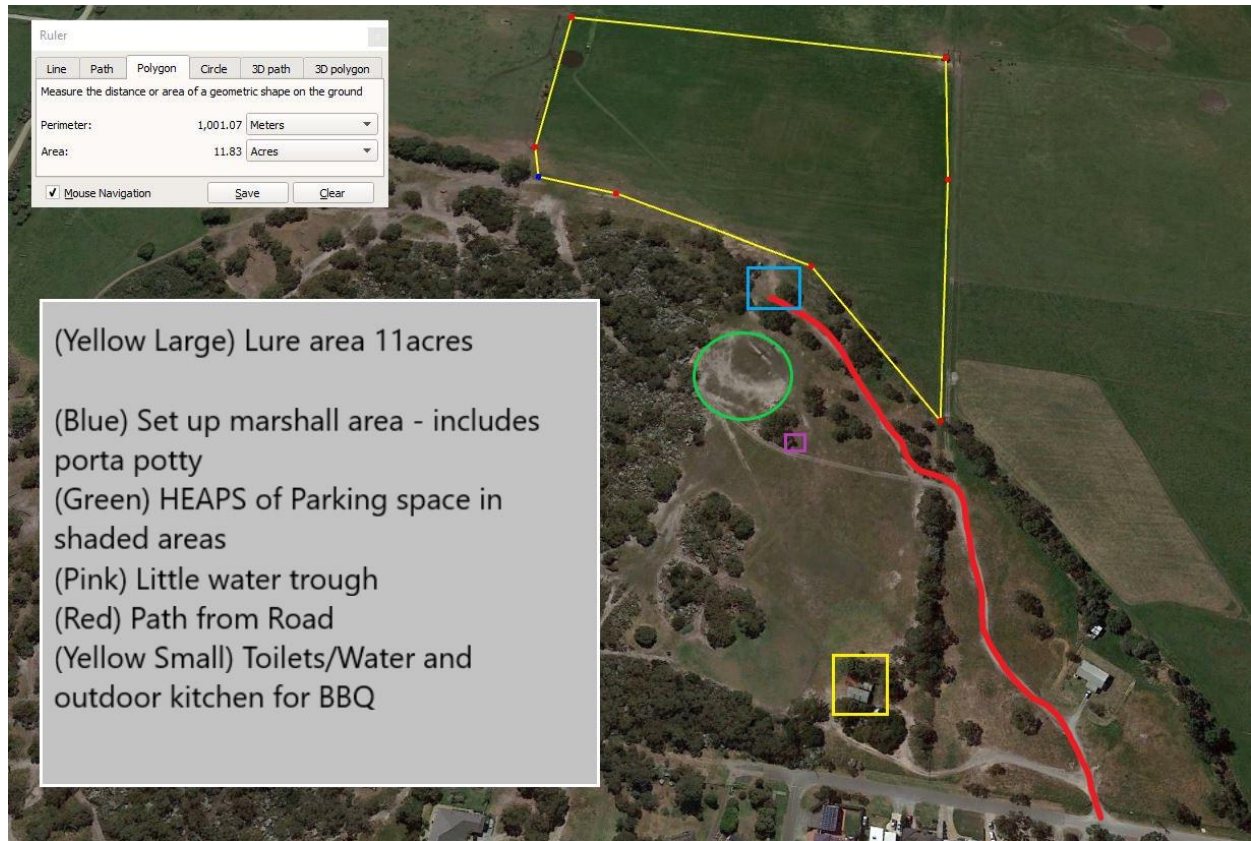
“A Food Truck Somewhere”
