I continue to organize the dog section for the Walbundrie Agricultural Society and am President of the Southern Region Hound Club of NSW that holds its double championship show in conjunction with the Southern Region Country Classic triple championship shows towards the end of June each year.

In 1980 I sat for and passed my Hound Group. This satisfied me for the time and I did not again get inspired until 1986 when I gained my Working Dog Group. I progressed from there and gained my All Breeds status in 2006. I have judged in all states of Australia and in New Zealand and in South Africa on two occasions.

The Moonwind prefix has established over 70 Champions over 50 plus years of breeding. I have also titled several Whippets carrying other prefixes who I have purchased in for bloodlines. My most treasured win was when my late Jade, Ch Moonwind Lady Chatterly who was awarded Best Exhibit in Show at the 1998 Whippet Association of Victoria Championship Show judged by Whippet specialist, Roma Wright-Smith of Silkstone Whippets, England.

I really enjoy judging as I continue to learn more at each appointment about the breeds I have the pleasure to assess.
