**GENERAL BUSINESS:**

**Executive Officer's Report**

The EO's Report advised that:

- Processing is at a 10 working day turnaround;
- There were 175 puppies registered in the period 05 December 2018 until 15 January 2019 compared to 332 for the same period in 2017 and 2018;
- 2249 puppies were registered in 2018.
- There are 1043 members including Life Members as at 16 January 2019 compared to 983 in 2018.
- The Hobart City Council is conducting another round of its Dog Management Policy and Hobart Canine Obedience Club has requested that we send correspondence to the HCC supporting their cause.
