Sweepstakes and Property Classes in order of Judging. Note dogs and bitches in all sweepstake and property classes will be judged together

Veterans Sweeps 7-10 years old – open to all dogs on the main register between the ages of 7-10 years old. Dogs can be desexed, clipped off or enjoying retirement.

Veterans Sweeps 10+ years – bring out your golden oldies open to all dogs on the main register over the age of 10. Dogs can be desexed, clipped off or enjoying retirement.

Puppy Sweeps – open to all puppies aged 3 months to 12 months of age.

Junior Sweeps – Open to all youngsters aged over 12 months and under 24 months.

Best Headed – best headed dog including structure, eyes and expression

Best Coat – looking at overall appearance of coat including colour, texture.

Best gaited – looking for the best moving beardie.

Parent and Progeny – dog or bitch with one of their offspring.

Owner Breeder Handler – looking for the best team of breeder, handler and owner. “team” can incorporate but not limited to overall appearance, repour with the dog and team performance.

Breeders Team – looking for the best breeder’s team for dogs under the same kennel prefix. Minimum two dog and maximum 4. We understand being a small breed we may need to accommodate multiple handlers across different teams.
