## Japanese Spitz Club of NSW

### COVIDsafe Plan Regulations for Championship Shows

#### Conditions of entry

- If you have mild symptoms, stay home and get tested.
- If you are awaiting test results, stay home and do not attend.
- If you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive within the 14 days before the show, stay home and do not attend.
- Attendees are encouraged to download the COVIDsafe app and have this running whilst in attendance.
- All attendees and entrants will adhere to government regulations. If there is a restriction in place that disallows you from attending, do not attend and the club will refund your entry costs.
- Visitors (those not owning of exhibiting an entrant or not living with an entered exhibitor) shall not be permitted to attend this event.
- All persons who are not officials or exhibitors must register their attendance with the secretary.
- A record of officials and staff present at the event shall be maintained by the secretary.
- Marked catalogue will serve as a record of attendees for contact tracing.
- Online entry is the only way to enter. No paper entries will be accepted.
- Catalogues will be emailed to exhibitors 1 hour before the show in accordance with regulation. Prepaid catalogues will be available on the day.
- Lapel cards will be emailed to exhibitors. Lapel cards will be available on the day individualised for each competitor in sealed bags with your catalogue
- There shall be no setting up of any exhibitor equipment prior to 7.00am on the day of the show.
- Gazebos must be spaced a minimum of 1.5m apart.
- Only members of the same household may share a gazebo.
- It is a requirement of entry that you must obey any instruction from club officials concerning compliance with Government Regulations concerning gatherings of people during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- No food or drink is to be shared between exhibitors.

#### Physical Distancing

- There shall be no congregating or setting up under ring awnings.
- Keep a distance of 1.5m between yourself and other people.
- No person shall encroach into the steward's safety zone, marked out by tape on the awning. Steward may leave their safety zone at their own discretion – no one may enter their safety zone.
- Do not hug, kiss, shake hands or pat anyone on the back.
- Hand sanitiser and antibacterial wipes will be made available by the club and all attendees are encouraged to use these or bring your own.
- Exhibitors will avoid touching dogs that are not their responsibility.
- Exhibitors and officials shall not use common writing implements, tables and chairs.
- Ring entrance shall be used for entry only. Ring exit shall be used for exit only. Physical distancing must be maintained at all times in and out of the ring.

#### Judging

- Exhibitors shall stand at arm's length from their exhibit as it is being examined by the judge – this will assist in the 1.5 metre physical distancing.
- The exhibitor will be responsible for mouthing the exhibit.
- Judges are encouraged to examine exhibits at arms' length to facilitate physical distancing.
- Where there is more than one exhibit in a class, exhibitors must adhere to physical distancing.
- Judges must wash/sanitise their hands between each exhibit.
