Property classes: 22 – Best Head, 23 – Best Coat, 24 – Best Tail, 25 – Best Gaited,

26 – Best Brace, 27 – QC

- **Brace:** for two exhibits six months of age or over and of the same breed, each of which has competed in at least one ordinary class at the same exhibition, is the property of the same owner and is handled in the judging ring by the same person.
- **QC:** for any exhibit entered in the regular classes that has a qualifying score in another discipline such as field, obedience, retrieving, agility, etc. A copy of pass or title must be supplied with entry.
- Dogs must be on the main register to be eligible for entry for all property classes and must be entered in the conformation show.
- Property classes must be entered prior to close of entries. You may enter and compete in both the property classes and the ordinary classes.
- Veterans will be eligible to compete for Challenge.
