Dogs SA Rules PART VIII EXHIBITIONS C 15. (b) There is to be no training on designated trial grounds within 28 days before trial.

SA Health Covid Safe Plan and RAFT Covid Plan will be adhered to.

Other than in the Exercise Areas designated by the Trial Manager, or his/her delegates, no dogs will be permitted to swim or train in or on the trial grounds. All dogs must be kept on a lead, either held in the hand or tethered, except when competing or being exercised in the designated area. **It is the Exhibitors responsibility to find out where the exercise area is at any time on the trial grounds.**
